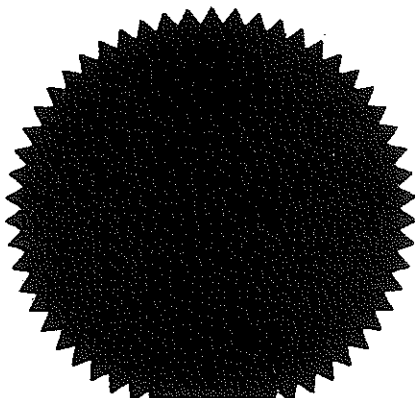



SEE PROBATE DIVORCE RULE 35.

The libellant shall set forth in the libel whether or not any previous libel or divorce, or petition or libel for annulling or affirming marriage or petition for separate support or for a decree of desertion or living apart for justifiable cause or of custody of children has been brought by either of the parties against the other; and if such a proceeding has been brought in any court other than that in which the libel is sought, the libellant shall file with the libel a certified copy of the libel or petition in such other proceeding together with a certified copy of the docket entries relating thereto.

STIPULATION

In the event that this Honorable Court shall grant a decree nisi in the above entitled case, it is agreed by and between the parties that the following may be made a part thereof:

1. That the libellee shall have the custody of the minor child of the parties.
2. That the libellee shall pay to the libellant the sum of fifteen (\$15.00) dollars each week for the support of said libellant.
3. That the libellant shall have the right to make and receive visits from the minor child of the parties at reasonable times.
4. It is agreed by and between that parties that the libellant agrees to join in a conveyance of the real estate standing in the names of the libellant and libellee, and in consideration of said conveyance and in settlement of all property rights, the libellee agrees to pay to the libellant the sum of sixty-five hundred (\$6,500.00) dollars. Said sum of money is to be paid to the libellant *FORTHWITH.*
