Identifying Data: (to include age, race, marital status, present circumstances)

Mr. LaGuer is 53 y/o Afro-Puerto Rican single male serving a life sentence for aggravated rape. Mr. LaGuer was sentenced on February 17, 1984.

Family History: (Number of siblings, Order in family History of any abuse, neglect, Substance abuse, domestic violence MH, developmental milestones met, Mr. LaGuer was born in Bronx NY. Client has two older brother ½ from mother's first marriage, and three older sisters ½ from father's first marriage, and two younger brothers from the same biological parents. As a child client reports he moved around secondary to father's work. Client lived in Mass, Puerto Rico, and upstate NY. Client reports an uneventful childhood. Client denies any history of domestic violence, physical and or sexual abuse. Client grew up only with biological siblings in the house but was in contact with his half sisters and brothers. Client reports reaching milestone as a child. . Client never married and has no children. Mother resides in NY, and remains in contact with family.

Educational History: (Years attended, special educational, bullying, highest grade completed)

Client completed college (Boston University-Bachelor in Interdisciplinary Studies) In school client reports he was a popular student average student involved in various organizations such as Drama Club, Class President. Although client moved around he reports no difficulty making friends.

Vocational History: (Types of Employment, length of employment, vocational training)

Following graduation from Boston University client enlisted in the Army. Client served three years, receiving an honorable discharge. Served in Germany. MOS was air conditioner and Refrigeration. Following discharge client was arrested and charged with aggravated Rape.

Legal History: History of Arrests including juvenile, incarcerations, type of offenses
Only one conviction which he is currently serving. Reports no juvenile history of arrests.

Psychiatric History: (Hospitalizations, outpatient care, medications, diagnosis)
Client reports no history of psychiatric hospitalization, and or outpatient counseling.
Client reports no family history of mental health in the family.

Substance History: (Identify each category of drugs used, past treatment, length of sobriety, drug of choice) Client reports no history of substance abuse. Client reports no history of substance abuse in family.

Medical History: Client report Cancer of the liver. Diagnosed in 1994 while incarcerated at Norfolk. At this point client has been advised to get a transplant. Client also diagnosed with latent diabetes controlled by medication diet and exercise. Client also has HTN but is not an issue at this time. Inmate was treated for Hep C. No family history of Cancer.

Formulation: Fifty three year old male serving an life sentence for Aggravated Rape. Client was sentenced in 1984. Reports no major disciplinary problems while in prison. Client understands and can articulate his desire to continue to live and wants the medical procedures in hopes of prolonging his life. There are no contraindications from a mental health perspective not to move forward.
